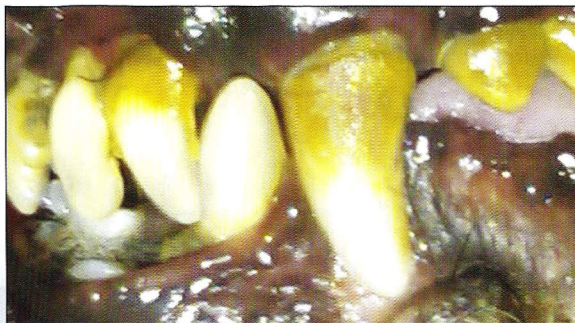
Step-by-Step

Plaque buildup

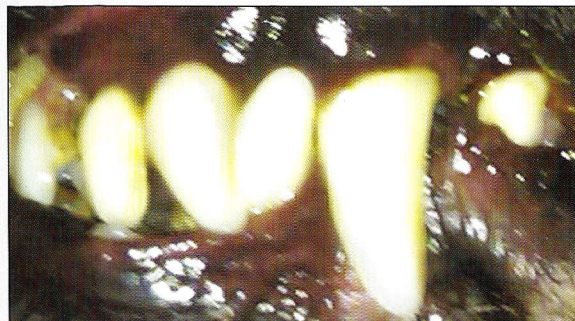
Allowing plaque to build up on your pet's teeth is the first stop on the road to gum disease. The most noticeable sign of plaque buildup is bad breath. If you notice that your pet's breath is less than fresh, it's time to visit the groomer or vet to have your pet's teeth cleaned, followed by regular daily home care with PlaqClnz® Gel.

Tartar buildup

If plaque buildup is left untreated, it hardens and becomes tartar—hard, yellow deposits along the gum line. Many dogs and cats experience significant tartar buildup as early as age two. Over time, the buildup creates “pockets” where the gum is forced away from the teeth, which can lead to gum disease.

Keeping your pet's teeth and gums healthy is an important part of caring for their overall health and can help add quality years to your pet's life.

Healthy mouth

- Safeguards pet from additional health risks

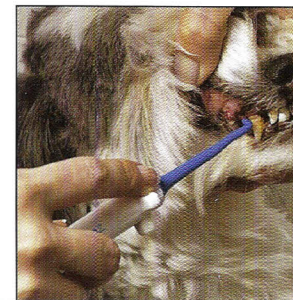
